The University is empowered to award degrees as specified under section 22 of the UGC Act, 1956 at its departments and to students studying in its Learner Support Centres (LSCs) with the approval of its statutory bodies/councils wherever required. - Establishment of a Centre for Media Production and Learning to accomplish the task of ODL (Open Distance Learning)
- More than 110 Learner Support Centres established in different colleges of Punjab
- More than 10000 students enrolled with the University in its first session.
- Declaration of term-end examinations result within 60 days
- Counselling sessions held regularly for learners in a congenial environment

Modus Operandi

University is committed to impart education through ODL mode. However, over a hundred Learner Support Centres (LSC_S) are established across the state of Punjab to handle the queries of the learners at initial level. These LSCs give personal support to the learners. At the Learner Support Centre, the student can interact with the designated programme coordinator and other co-learners. The learner also has access to the library and other learning material available at the learner support centre. A detailed list of these centres is given in the prospectus.

Schools of JGND PSOU

Jagat Guru Nanak Dev Punjab State Open University has established six schools of studies covering various disciplines of learning:

- 2. School of Business Management and Commerce
- 3. School of Social Sciences and Liberal Arts

- 6. School of Education and Vocation

Programmes

The University offers various conventional and innovative Certificates, Diplomas, Graduate and Post Graduate Degree programmes which have been developed after need-based surveys. They are launched with the view to fulfil the learners' needs for:

- Continuing education and professional development at work place
- Self-enhancement
- Diversification and updating the knowledge and empowerment

Modular Approach to Programmes

2020 following a flexible arrangement of teaching and learning. Keeping this objective in mind, the University follows a modular approach to programme development. This approach provides flexibility in the combination of courses as well as methods. This allows learners to follow their own pace of learning. Under this approach, each course is allocated a certain credit weightage. A learner enrolled in a modular programme can exit the programme at a designated point and can obtain a certificate or diploma, depending on the number of credits completed. Modularity is also implemented by providing options for multiple entries to the degree programmes. This approach helps students in meeting their immediate professional needs and also provides space for upgrading their knowledge/skill as per their requirements and convenience.

Credit System

(i) Defining Credit in ODL

The University follows the 'Credit System' for all of its programmes. Each credit is equivalent to 30 hours of learner study comprising all learning activities (i.e. reading, assimilating the study learning material, listening to audio, watching video, attending counselling sessions either online or at the requisite LSC and writing assignments responses). Completion of an academic programme (Degree or Diploma) requires successful completion of the assignments, practicals, projects and term-end examinations as per the requirements of each course in a programme.

(ii) Choice Based Credit System (CBCS)

The Bachelor's Degree Programmes offered by the University follow the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) introduced by UGC. The CBCS allows learners' flexibility to study at one's own pace along with greater choice of interdisciplinary, intradisciplinary and skill-based courses. The CBCS model helps integrate education with global standards.

Programme Delivery

The methodology of programme delivery followed by an Open University is distinct from that of conventional universities. Open University follows a learner-centric model where the learner is an active participant in the pedagogical (teaching and learning) process. The mode of delivery of instruction is in the

form of e-contents through the online mode, the university LMS portal. All the courses of the University are developed following the 4-quadrant instructional model consisting of videos, texts, and self-assessment.

Quadrant I: It contains video and audio lectures prepared by the faculty of the University in an organized form to which the learner can have access on the University portal.

Quadrant II: It contains the self-instructional material for both theory and practical components of the programme and is made available to the learners in the form of e-books comprising units for every course.

Quadrant III: It contains web resources such as further references, related links, open-source content on internet, books including e-books etc. to further add to learners' sphere of knowledge

Quadrant IV: It contains the self-assessment component that would include Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs), quizzes, assignments and solutions and a discussion forum for clarifications on general misconceptions.

Integrating 21st Century Skills through Open and Distance learning @ PSOU

The rapid pace of technology has led to numerous changes in society and the labour market. Society has witnessed a shift from a static industrial society to a dynamic knowledge society. Even jobs have changed from routinized production to one which requires more flexibility and problem-solving abilities. With these changes, the globe is witnessing the birth of an innovative economy. In this changing environment to participate effectively, students need to think critically, communicate effectively, collaborate with diverse peers, solve complex problems, adopt a global mind-set, and engage with information and communications technologies. The experts have recognised three categories of new age skills i.e Learnin Skills, Litracy Skills, Life Skills. which are also known as 21st Century skills.

Jaga Guru Nanak Dev Punjab State Open University provides a basket of degree, diploma and certificate programmes that comprehensively develop these skills among the learners e.g. the B.A. (Liberal Arts) programme of the School of Social Science and Liberal Arts has core course, skill enhancement, value-based learning components which provide comprehensive learning skills to the students. Similarly, the certificate courses of School of Science and Emerging Technologies focus on developing new-age technology skills among learners. School of Business Management and Commerce aims to develop thorough business acumen along with entrepreneurship abilities, leadership skills, social and life skills required to meet the Challenges of the contemporary corporate world.

The inter and multidisciplinary outlook of many programmes enables learners to apply technologically enhanced tools of problem-solving to business and commerce arena e.g. Goods and Services Tax Filing, Income Tax Filing and Documentation, Computer-Aided Accounting are some of the innovatively designed courses offered by the University. All the courses offered by the University especially focus on tangible learning and life skills that lead to career readiness. The courses focus to develop effective communication skills which are of utmost importance for students to effectively convey their ideas in all their life endeavours. Eventually, these courses help learners to adapt to the world more efficiently and prepare them to play a vital role in nation-building.

Lateral Entry after the first year is allowed in each course, subject to the eligibility.

Migration Policy of the University:

- (i) The students who have passed a particular semester/ year of a degree/ Master Level Programme from another college or University and wants to migrate and take admission in JGND PSOU in the next sem/ year of that particular Programme. POSTGRADUATE PROGRAMME MASTER OF COMMERCE (M.COM.)

The school of Business Management and Commerce of Jagat Guru Nanak Dev State Open University, Patiala has started M.COM. from the session 2022-23. The University has adopted choice based credit system which has been introduced by University Grant Commission. This is a Flagship programme covering disciplinary, interdisciplinary and skill based subjects. Its focus is to develop accounting and finance skills among students. 







- 3. It helps to reach marginalized groups through its special features.







RAGGING: Prohibition, Prevention and Punishment

The University Grants Commission vide its letter no F.1-16/2007 (CPP-II) dated 17th June, 2009, has reiterated the ban on ragging of students in institutions of Higher Learning. The students are therefore directed to strictly desist from any kind of ragging during their presence in the Learning Support Centres.

General Information

Before filling out the admission cum Examination form, students are advised to follow the instructions given below:-

- Read all the instructions given on the Admission portal or in this Prospectus carefully.
- Check the eligibility conditions of the programmes for which you are seeking admission and if you fulfil the eligibility conditions then only fill out the form.
- Fill in all the information asked in the online form carefully. In case of any doubt or query, either read the Prospectus or call at 94630-82523 (9:00 am to 5:00 pm) or contact helpdesk at admissioncell@psou.ac.in
- While filling up the form please be sure of the spellings of your name, the name of your father and mother.
- You are advised to provide the correct postal address/correspondence address as well as your mobile phone number and E-mail id.
- While filling up the online Admission cum Examination form candidate should indicate
 preferences for cities of Examination Centre of his/her choice as mentioned in the
 prospectus/website. The University reserves the right to abolish any city for Examination
 Centre.
- Fee can be deposited "ONLINE "through Net Banking /Credit Cards/Debit Cards. The Students are advised to keep the photocopy of the University Fee Receipt.

- Fee once paid at the time of admission to any programmes shall not be refunded (except refundable securities):
 - o If a candidate is not enrolled because he/she has not submitted the required certificate/documents by the last date fixed for the purpose or submitted bogus or forged documents, his/her fee shall not be refunded in any case.
 - o If a candidate drops out in the middle of the programme, the fee paid by him/her, shall not be refunded.

• Refund of Fee (specific provision)

- o If a candidate is found ineligible by the University, then the fee paid by him/her shall be refunded after a deduction of 25% of the fee paid by him/her.
- o Whenever a refund is permissible, the candidate must apply for refund to the Registrar, JGNDPSOU within three months of the date of issue of the letter of ineligibility by JGNDPSOU failing which the request for refund will not be entertained.

Verification of the Original Certificates/Documents

Admission will be provisional till the verification of the original certificates/documents and their subsequent confirmation by the University. The students are required to bring the original certificates/documents as and when the University asks for them. These will be returned to the students after verification. The University reserves the right to cancel the provisional admission and/or the result of any part of the examination of the concerned programmes of any student whose certificates/documents are found to be bogus, forged and tampered with.

In such cases, the fee deposited shall not be refunded.

Thus, it is the responsibility of the student to submit the required authentic certificates and documents within the stipulated period as and when demanded, failing which his/her admission shall stand cancelled without any notice.

Change in Subject/Medium of Instruction

While requesting for change of subjects one may keep in mind the permitted combination of subjects mentioned in the Prospectus.

- I. A student may be permitted to change his/her subject/medium of instruction within one month of the commencement of the session or within one month of the date of admission whichever is later without paying any fee. For JGNDPSOU students, the session may be deemed to have commenced with effect from the last date on which the study material is mailed or made available on LMS Portal to the student by JGNDPSOU.
- II. The student can change his/her optional subject or medium of instruction or programme without any extra fee within one month of his/her admission. However, after one month, the change will only be done by paying a requisite late fee within a time framework of fifteen (15) days.
